**EQUIP** the church by training pastors and Christian leaders through theological education and professional development. Investing in people is how we can change a nation.

**SUPPORT** the church by developing a system to provide sustainable access to clean water. Water is a fundamental human need and allows the local church to flourish.

## WHY

With South Sudan as the world's newest country, we have a unique opportunity to **build a nation for Christ**.


## WHERE

As a country barely a decade old, **South Sudan** has very little infrastructure, goods, or services.

- Roughly the size of Texas
- Less than 2% with access to electricity
- Less than 200 miles of paved roads
- **1 out of 2** don't have clean water
- **3 out of 4** can't read or write

## HOW

We partner with the people of South Sudan to provide every village with sustainable access to **clean water** and **gospel by radio**.



# RADIO

In a nation where **3 out of 4 people can't read or write**, radio is the best way to provide gospel content and community development programs in local dialects, which is why we're building a radio network to reach every village.

## PROVIDE THE ACCESS

We build radio stations, work with local pastors to produce radio programs, distribute solar radios, and deliver them to our listeners.

## SUSTAIN THE IMPACT

Our radio stations are operated by local leaders and funded by local churches through annual listener support campaigns.

# PEOPLE

**People are the way** to build a nation for Christ, which is why we focus on providing pastor training, certifying local pump mechanics, and equipping radio professionals.

## PROVIDE THE ACCESS

We host pastor conferences, offer theological education, and provide job-related development in order to raise up local pastors and professionals.

## SUSTAIN THE IMPACT

We empower our South Sudanese staff and local church leaders to carry on the work independently in the future.

# WATER

Clean water is a basic human need that **1 out of 2 South Sudanese don't have access** to, which is why we focus on drilling new wells and providing the spare parts and training for an ongoing well repair and maintenance program.

## PROVIDE THE ACCESS

We establish and educate local water committees and give them access to the spare parts and training required for a sustainable water system.

## SUSTAIN THE IMPACT

We certify pump mechanics and assign them to provide ongoing maintenance for communities through annual service agreements.
